

ORDINANCE 2020-09

AN ORDINANCE TO PROCEED WITH THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT
ALONG WILLEKE AVENUE, SOUTH JOHNSON STREET, AND SOUTH
SIMON STREET (WILLEKE AVENUE PHASE II PROJECT) AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ada has previously adopted a resolution declaring the necessity for the public improvements along Willeke Avenue, South Johnson Street and South Simon Street within the village, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to proceed with such improvements after public meeting and discussion as to design and cost thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ADA, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That it is the intention of the Council of the Village of Ada, Ohio to proceed with the public improvements in accordance with the provisions of the resolution of necessity adopted under R.C. Section 727.12, which said improvements have been further set forth in design, specification and estimated cost as set forth in Section 3 hereof, and such improvements shall so proceed.


SECTION 2. That the estimated assessments prepared by the Village Administrator and filed with the Fiscal Officer on July 27, 2020, be and are hereby adopted.

SECTION 3. That the plans, specifications and estimated cost of the public improvement revised by the Village Administrator with a total cost of \$1,025,311.56, including \$30,836 as cost of intersections and \$193,500 to be paid by special assessment, and being the same filed with the Fiscal Officer on July 27, 2020, be and are hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, the particular necessity being the need to comply with the legislation timeline as needed to submit final assessments to the County Auditor.
