Dear Mayor and Councilors,

RE: Motion for 2022 operation of the Village Green Waste Site

The Ada Tree Commission is requesting Village Council to consider the startup of a Village Green Waste Site. The Green Waste Site provides a place for Village residents to dispose of green waste, such as yard clippings, leaves and fallen tree limbs. The resulting compost and natural wood mulch would then be available for no charge to the residents of the Village.

LOCATION: The location of the Village Green Waste Site would be off of Pebble Court which is located to the east of the Village water plant lagoons. The address is 514 E Lincoln Ave – rear of lot. The site is secured with a chain and concrete structures. Signage would be displayed with hours and conditions of use.

HOURS: Starting September 19th, 2022, and through November 30th, 2022, The Village Green Waste Site would be available for drop off or pick up Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 4:00 by appointment only. Residents will call the Utility office for the scheduled time. It is anticipated that this schedule will be adjusted for 2023.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS: Brush, Leaves, Grass Clippings, Biodegradable paper bags, tree limbs (up to 4" in diameter) herbaceous garden and landscape material.

UNACCEPTED MATERIALS: NO PLASTIC BAGS OR PLASTIC OF ANYTYPE, Household items, tires, food items, garbage, construction materials, man-made items, trash.

CONDITIONS FOR USE: This site is for the residents of Ada only and is not for commercial use, proof of residency required, green material can only be from residents property, the Village will load compost by the tractor scoop only, any other means of loading will be by the property owner, the Village of Ada will not be responsible for assistance in unloading, or any damage or injury to vehicles or equipment resulting in the use of the Village Green Site. This site is only available for use when accompanied by an authorized agent of the Village.

VILLAGE CRUSHED CONCRETE: The Village will have a crushed concrete pile located at the Village Green Waste Site for pickup by Village Residents for the use in Village Right of Way improvements. This would be available by the tractor scoop or by property owner loading in their own container.

Ada Council approves green waste drop-off for 2022

At the Sept. 6 regular meeting of the Ada Village Council, councilors approved the startup of a Village green waste site in response to a request by the Ada Tree Commission.

In the attached memo, Village Administrator Jamie Hall outlines the service, which will be for Ada residents only.

By appointment, residents will be allowed to bring "green waste" such as yard clippings, leaves and tree branches to the Village site at 514 E. Lincoln. See the attachment for a detailed description of what may and what may not be brought to the site. Unloading must be done by the resident.

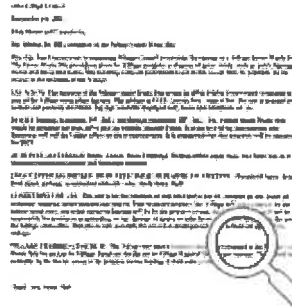
The program will begin September 19 and continue through November 30, 2022. Hours of operation will be 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. with an appointment. Scheduling will be done through the Utility office at 419-634-4045.

An expanded program is anticipated for 2023.

Compost and crushed concrete will also be distributed to residents at the site.

In reviewing the program, Hall mentioned his discussions with other communities and noted that expanded hours and a security system will be considered in the 2023 budgeting process. He emphasized that the facility is not for use by contractors and will not accept construction debris.
