### Tote placement rules

Follow these simple steps to ensure your waste is collected quickly and easily:

- All waste and recycling must be placed at the curb.
- On your scheduled day of service, place your waste tote at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m.
- Position your tote no further than 3 feet away from the road with handle facing toward your residence.
- Position your tote 3 feet away from any obstacles, such as a mailbox or light pole.
- Do not park your car in front of the container.
- Place all waste inside your container and do not overfill the container.
- Bulk item pickup on scheduled refuse collection day must be scheduled 48 hours in advance 1-800-491-1115.
- Remove totes from the curb within 24 hours of collection.



### Waste rules

- Steel drums
- Pharmaceuticals
- Asbestos
- Ashes
- Hazardous or bio-hazard material
- Paint and solvents or any other liquids
- Tires, lead acid batteries and car parts
- Items over 50 pounds

### Recycling rules

#### Acceptable Recyclable Items—

- Clean paper, cardboard (OCC) and newsprint
- Glass food and beverage containers (all colors)
- Rigid plastic “food and beverage containers” (#1 thru #7)
- Steel, aluminum and bi-metal food and beverage containers
- Gable-top milk, gravy and soup cartons

### Non-Acceptable Recyclable Items—

- Light bulbs, mirrors, window glass and ceramics
  - Containers with food and liquid residue remaining
  - Pizza boxes and wet paper products
  - Garden hoses
  - All metals except for those identified as acceptable

### Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste materials can be placed in with your trash for collection. Yard waste includes grass, leaves and garden waste. Tree limbs will also be collected if they are bundled and tied in 4-foot lengths, are no more than 2” in diameter and weigh no more than 40 pounds.

Christmas trees will be picked up as part of the normal collection service at no additional charge. Remove all ornaments and lights, cut the tree in 6-foot lengths and place the pieces next to your bin or bag at the curb.

### Handicap service

Residents that are physically unable to transport containers to the curb can have them picked up beside the house at no additional charge. There can be no resident living in the home having the ability to move containers to the curb. In all cases, yard waste and bulk items must be taken to the curb for collection.
